GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Competitions Starting from both 1st and 10th Tees simultaneously

The Committee would remind members that when Competitions are in progress (Gentlemen, Ladies or Mixed), the course is closed to non-participants until COMPLETION OF THE 'CROSSOVER', ie for AM Competitions, the 1st and 10th tees should normally be clear by approximately mid-day.

Members not participating in the Competition should UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES attempt to 'Tee-off' without special permission of the Secretary or Club Professional.

For details of competition dates please refer to fixture list and the current edition of the Club Newsletter.

1.b Members are reminded to alternate on both 1st and 10th Tees after playing 9 holes.

2. Course Closure prior to Competitions

The course will be closed before the commencement of play for mens major competitions.

3. Weekend starting times

Members must report to the Starter (normally the Professional Shop) on Saturday and Sunday mornings before commencing play.

4. Car Parks

Members are requested to park on the far side of the car park, leaving the area near the entrance for the restaurant. Will staff and officers of the club entitled to park in the small car park please ensure they park correctly and KEEP CLEAR THE AREA immediately in front of the main entrance to the clubhouse.

5. Mobile Phones

Must be switched to silent when in the clubhouse or on the course.

DRESS RULES

Members and Visitors (non-golfers included) are expected to conform to dress regulations at all times.

MAY I REMIND YOU THAT WE OPERATE A DRESS CODE BOTH IN THE CLUBHOUSE AND ON THE GOLF COURSE. TO AVOID EMBARRASSMENT PLEASE ENSURE YOU AND YOUR GUESTS ARE PROPERLY ATTIRED.

PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT IF YOU OR ANY MEMBER OF YOUR GROUP DO NOT CONFORM TO THE DRESS CODE YOU MAY BE ASKED TO LEAVE.

DENIM JEANS AND TRAINERS ARE NOT PERMITTED AT ANY TIME ON OR OFF THE COURSE.

Clubhouse Lounge

Up to 7pm normal golf attire is permitted, with the exception of golf shoes. Golf shoes are NOT permitted at any time in the lounge.

After 7pm Gentlemen may wear smart casual, ie shirts with collars that are buttoned all the way up the front. Ladies will be expected to maintain reasonable standards of dress.

On Course

SHIRTS Always with a collar, never without

Always wear tucked into waistband of trousers or shorts, with the exception of ladies

SHORTS Always tailored and no more than 2" above the knee

SOCKS Either short & **white** (calf length), never short & coloured

Or, long socks (knee length any colour)

GOLF SHOES Always wear socks with shoes

COMPETITION RULES

- a) General
- 1 All competitions shall be played in accordance with the latest edition of "The Rules of Golf" together with all revisions and amendments as issued by "The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews".
 - 2 Local Rules as issued by the Committee together with all revisions and amendments shall form part of "The Rules of Golf" as if such Local Rules were embodied therein.
 - 3 The Committee shall only accept an entry to a competition when all conditions of entry have been fulfilled.
 - 4 Entry to all competitions shall be accepted on the strict understanding that the competitor is available to complete all stages of the competition.
 - 5 The Committee reserves the right to take appropriate action in cases where it is known that a competitor has not fulfilled his obligation and not adhered to the competition rules.
 - 6 The Committee reserves the right to modify competition rules according to prevailing circumstances.
- b) Drawn Competitions (Committee responsible to arrange play)
- 1 Entries will be accepted by members entering their name on the entry sheet or by such other methods of entry as determined by the Committee.
 - 2 Entry sheets shall be posted 4 clear weeks before the date of the competition or at such other times as considered reasonable by the Committee.
 - 3 Members may request early (E) or late (L) starting times for certain drawn competitions.
 - 4 Entry sheets will normally be removed and the draw carried out one clear weekend before the competition.
 - 5 All late entries and cancellations before the day of play must be notified through the office. On day of play late entries and cancellations shall be through the starter, normally the Professional Shop. Any other method of late entry, cancellation or change in the draw unless authorised by the Committee will not be accepted. (see Rule b-9).
 - 6 Competitors must report to the starter (normally the Professional Shop) 5 minutes before the allocated starting time.
 - 7 Any entry fee or fees shall be paid before the commencement of play. Such fee or fees shall be at the discretion of the Committee.
 - 8 All late entries shall be subject to twice the entry fee or fees.
 - 9 All cancellations without prior notice to the office or on the day of play to the starter shall be subject to a fine of twice the entry fee for singles competitions and treble the entry fee for pairs competitions. Such fines shall be paid before entry is accepted in any future competition. Rules regarding payment for cancellations with respect to Guest Day etc. will be posted prior to the event.
- c) Undrawn Competitions (Competitors responsibility to arrange play)
- 1 Entry will be accepted by members reporting to the starter (normally the Professional Shop) before the commencement of play where it may be necessary to sign an entry sheet.
 - 2 Any entry fee or fees shall be paid before the commencement of play. Such fee or fees shall be at the discretion of the Committee.
 - 3 Any outstanding fines shall be paid before the commencement of play.
 - 4 Each competitor shall be responsible for arranging to be accompanied by a "marker". The "marker" may be a fellow competitor.
- d) Stroke Play - General

- 1 All score cards shall be returned to the Committee on completion of play (15 minutes is considered a reasonable time). Such cards shall either be placed in the Competitions Box or to such other place as advised by the Committee. This will also include members entering their own competition scores on the computer, when instructed, before scorecards are deposited in the competitions box.
 - 2 Failure to return the score card to the Committee whether complete or not shall subject the member to a fine equal to the original entry fee. Such fine shall be paid before entry is accepted in any future competition.
 - 3 Unless advised otherwise by the Committee ties shall be decided on a count back system, ie, best nett score over back 9 holes (holes 10 to 18), if still tied repeated over last 6 holes (holes 13 to 18), last 3 holes (holes 16 to 18). Last hole (18) If still tied the process shall be repeated over the front 9 holes. (Holes to be considered running 1 to 18 as the score card, irrespective of where the round commenced).
 - 4 The Committee may appoint a referee for any competition. In the absence of a referee the Committee shall settle any doubt as to procedure. Any competitor who has 'doubt' shall append a note to the score card advising of such 'doubt'.
- e) Match Play Competitions
- 1 The Committee shall be responsible for the draw in match play.
 - 2 Matches shall be played within the time limits laid down.
 - 3 Each side in a draw shall have equal responsibility for arranging the match. Failure to play the match within the time limits, and no action being taken under Rule e 4) shall result in both sides being disqualified from the competition.
 - 4 In the event of a side not being able to arrange the match, they may make a claim to proceed to the next round or in the event of the final to be awarded the competition. Such claims must be made in writing within the period of the round. Verbal claims will only be considered at the discretion of the Committee. Decisions by the competitions committee shall be final.
 - 5 Extensions of time shall only be granted at the discretion of the Committee. Such extensions shall normally be granted in respect of a whole round.
- f) Handicaps
- 1 The handicapping system as laid down by the Council of National Golf Unions shall be observed.
 - 2 The maximum handicap in all adult competitions unless otherwise agreed by the Committee shall be:-
Men 28, Ladies 36, Juniors 18
 - 3 Members must notify the Handicap Secretary in writing within 7 days if such member be advised of a change of handicap at any other club.
 - 4 Where a competition extends over a period, the Competition/Handicap Committee shall adjudicate on matters concerning revisions of handicaps during competition.
 - 5 In all qualifying competitions a player will receive full handicap allowance (subject to due allowance as laid down).

LOCAL RULES

1. **Out of Bounds**

As defined by white stakes and beyond all boundary hedges and fences. On the fairway of the 6th hole and beyond to the left, up to the white stakes when playing the 3rd hole.

The internal out of bounds white stakes are significant when playing the 3rd hole but are classified as immovable objects when playing other holes.

2. **Water Hazards**

All ponds and ditches are water hazards (yellow stakes) or lateral water hazards (red stakes).

3. **Paths**

Relief **MUST** be taken from all paths, including the grit covered area adjacent to the 18th green. Relief **MAY** be obtained from a ball coming to rest on a BRIDLE PATH **ACROSS** the 3rd, 6th, 10th, 11th and 18th, through the green. Rule 25-1.

4. **Tractor Ruts**

Through the green, a ball that comes to rest in or on a Tractor Rut may be lifted without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to the spot where it lay but not nearer the hole.

Exception: A player may not obtain relief under this Local Rule if it is clearly unreasonable for him to make a stroke because of interference by anything other than the condition covered by the Local Rule.

5. **Stones in Bunkers** (Rules 24-1)

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions (Rule 24-1).

6. **Trees/Bushes, Flowerbeds**

Relief **MUST** be taken from all staked trees/bushes (Rule 24-2(B)).

Relief **MUST** also be taken from all flower beds.

7. **Ground under repair**

Play is prohibited from any area marked G.U.R. Temporary greens and drainage gullies are defined as G.U.R. (Rule 25-1).

8. **Fixed Sprinkler heads**

Pop-up sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions (Rule 24).

9. **Red/Yellow Stakes, Yardage Markers, Signs and Hoops**

All are deemed to be immovable obstructions in all circumstances (Rule 24).

WINTER RULES

(With Effect from 1st November to 31 March)

Preferred Lies and Winter Rules

A ball lying on any closely mown area through the green may be lifted without penalty and cleaned. Before lifting the ball, the player must mark its position. Having lifted the ball he must place it on a spot within six (6) inches of and not nearer the hole than where it originally lay, that is not in a hazard and not on a putting green.

A player may place his ball only once, and it is in play when it has been placed. (Rule 20.4). If the ball fails to come to rest on the spot on which it is placed and it subsequently moves, there is no penalty and the ball must be played as it lies, unless the provisions of any other rule apply.

If the player fails to mark the position of the ball before lifting it or moves the ball in any other manner, such as rolling it with a club, he incurs a penalty of one stroke.

EMBEDDED BALL THROUGH THE GREEN

A ball embedded in its own pitchmark in the ground, other than sand, may be lifted without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to where it lay but not nearer the hole. The ball when dropped must first strike a party of the course through the green.

Exception: A player may not obtain relief under this Local Rule if it is clearly unreasonable for him to make a stroke because of interference other than the condition covered by this Local Rule.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE

Match Play - Loss of Hole; Stroke Play - Two Strokes. If a player incurs the general penalty for a breach of this Local Rule, no additional penalty under the Local Rule is applied.

The above to be read in conjunction with the Local Rules.
